Presided by PLANTU, an international drawing contest is launched by the NGO Human Resources Without Borders (rhsansfrontieres.org), to help fight against forced labor of migrant workers by informing them about their rights, and raising awareness of the companies.

Forced labor, has recently been highlighted by Amnesty International on the construction sites of the 2022 FIFA World Cup in Qatar, affecting almost 20 million migrant workers in the world.


These drawings are intended to be displayed in factories, on construction sites and in subcontractors companies which employing migrants that they do not speak the local language, the drawings can simply explain their basic rights.

The language obstacles will be removed and the human rights will be respected at workplace.

The first jury consists of migrant workers in Malaysia, to ensure that the message expressed by their drawings is adapted.

The final selection will be composed by a jury presided by Plantu (Le Monde), and the renowned international designers (Xia, Paresh and Jiho), NGO Tenaganita in Malaysia (The president, Irene Fernandez, awarded the Right Livelihood Award), Gilles Waeldin vice-president of Malaysian French Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MFCCI) and Toulouse Business School (TBS).
